Long experience with wind harp recordings in Brittany; development and construction of individually designed wind harps in courses and open projects.

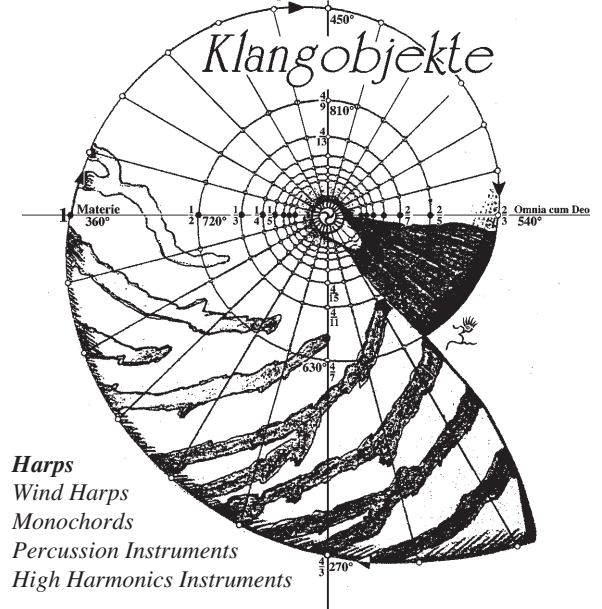

Big Celtic Harps

36 strings, A-a^{'''}, Tynex- or gut strings. Available wood: walnut, maple, wild cherry, oak, ash, padouk. Height 152 cm, weight ca. 10-12 kg, Various semitone lever systems (*Robinson, Loveland, or Peter Brough*). The soundboard is made of pine or redwood (*Sequoia gigantea*).

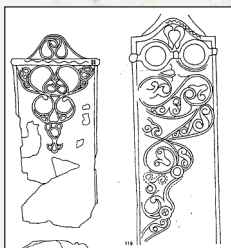

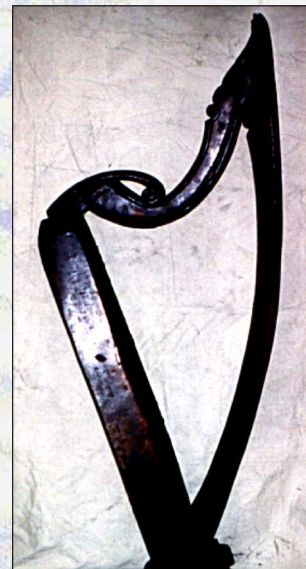
